DEAR FRIENDS,

2022 was a year of growth, celebration, planning and deliberation.

The Coalition has grown in response to the increased need for our services. Over the past 3 years we have distributed Emergency Rental Assistance funding to Frederick County residents behind in their rent and under threat of eviction.

In that short time, The Coalition's annual budget ballooned from \$1.7 million to \$11 million. We've added several new staff members to support the management of distributing the Emergency Rental Assistance funding.

In April of 2022 we opened the Emergency Family Shelter and are very pleased to announce this new program has achieved exactly what our clients needed. While at the shelter families receive a source of stability, access to vital resources and the support to receive the tools necessary to return to sustainable housing.

With the successful completion of the Beyond Shelter Campaign and the new Emergency Family Shelter going live, the time was ideal to take stock of what we've accomplished over the past several years - especially during the haze of the Covid Pandemic.

It was time to begin shaping the organization's vision for the future. The Coalition's Staff and Board of Directors undertook a Strategic Planning process to help the Coalition provide focus and clarity as we map the organization's path forward. This road map will provide focus and clarity for the work we do over the next several years.

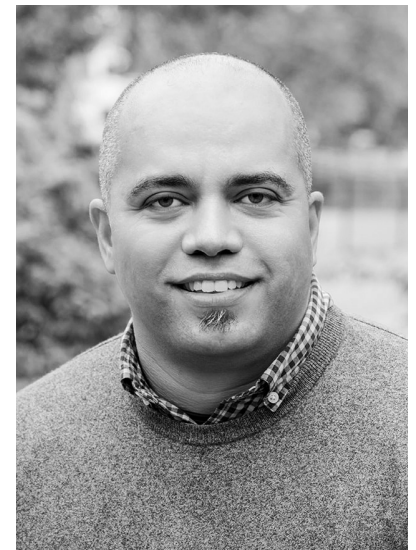
As a part of the Strategic Planning process we:

- Conducted a SWOT analysis to identify the organization's successes, strengths weaknesses, opportunities for growth and the challenges preventing us from achieving our goals.
- We conducted an environmental scan to determine how our donors, volunteers, funders, and community partners in the community perceive the organization and their understanding of our services. The environmental scan confirmed our own perception - that most people are well educated about our shelter services but are largely unaware of the other programs and services that we provide.

Our Strategic Planning process identified four critical issues and the strategies to address them:

1. Strengthen internal operations to ensure reliable and sustainable funding, prepare us for unanticipated adverse events and be good stewards of our resources.
2. Define and strengthen the board's role in accomplishing the Coalition's goals.
3. Develop a program evaluation system to measure both outputs and outcomes/effectiveness of our current programs on an ongoing basis. We will determine the need for new/expanded programs with an emphasis on expanding the continuum of care.
4. Engage and excite the community about our mission and educate residents about our expanded programs and services.

The Staff and Board of Directors are committed to being the best that we can be to serve Frederick County residents and continue to be the go-to organization for people seeking shelter. I look forward to keeping you updated on our progress moving forward.

OUR SERVICES

EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAMS

The Alan P. Linton, Jr. Emergency Shelter offers homeless adults a place to sleep, shower, and receive laundry assistance.

The Emergency Family Shelter provides a place of stability for families experiencing hardships due to homelessness and poverty. Our goal is to keep families together and return them to permanent housing.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR EMERGENCY HEALTHCARE

Prescription assistance is available through our partnerships with local pharmacies to help with the cost of life-sustaining medication.

We provide emergency dental assistance for simple dental procedures, such as tooth extraction or fillings. Assistance may also be available for comprehensive procedures such as root canals or dentures.

AFTER SHELTER PROGRAMS

After the Storm is a one-year rehousing program to support people who are transitioning from the shelter to permanent housing. Clients have access to case management support, budget coaching, security deposit assistance, rental, energy, and/or prescription assistance, family mentoring and training courses, and a car referral through Second Chances Garage.



IN MEMORIAL – ED HOFFMAN (1937-2023)

With gratitude we recognize Ed Hoffman, a longtime volunteer and friend of the Coalition. He was passionate about finding ways to support the unsheltered in our community. BEYOND SHELTER CAMPAIGN

We are open! In April of 2022 the Coalition began welcoming families to the new Emergency Family Shelter on Hayward Road. The new Emergency Family Shelter provides temporary housing and supportive services for up to ten families and offers family suites with personal bathrooms, two laundry rooms, community kitchen, living area, counseling rooms, and a children’s playroom.

The Beyond Shelter Campaign to establish the new Emergency Family Shelter is the Coalition’s largest fundraising initiative in our 40-year history. With the generosity of the Frederick Community, we surpassed the \$3.5 million fundraising goal to support the renovation and construction of the White-Hayward Farmhouse, operating expenses for the first year, and establishing an endowment fund to support the program in perpetuity.



Each time we gaze upon the new Emergency Family Shelter or travel past it, may we be reminded that it stands tall with strength and steadfastness as a beacon of hope that watches over the community, ever present to convey a spirit of "Welcome Home."

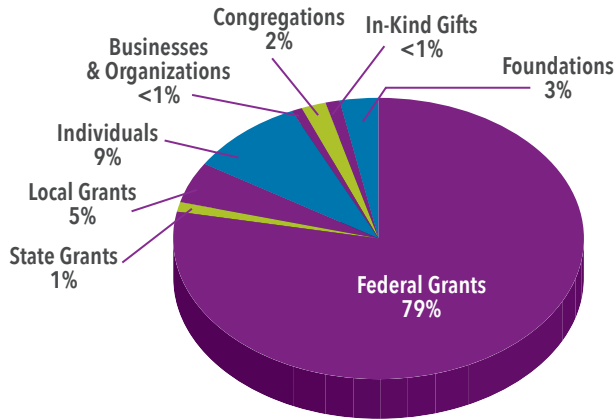

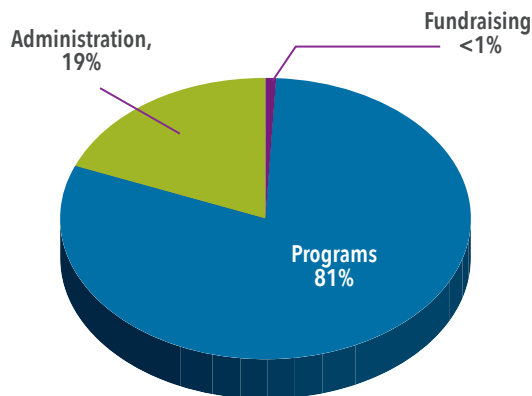
